Dear TK/Kindergarten Students and Parents,

As the first day of the 2022-2023 school year rapidly approaches, Santa Rosa Technology Magnet School (SRTMS) would like to extend a warm welcome to our new transitional kindergartner (TK) students, kindergartner students, and their families. We look forward to you joining the SRTMS family. The upcoming year will be one of rigorous learning and numerous adventures as the students begin their academic careers.

The TK/Kindergarten events will begin the week of August 15. On **Monday, August 15**, we will begin our TK/kindergarten assessments. We will continue with those assessments on **Tuesday, August 16**. The exact date and time for your child's individual assessment will be sent to you as the time gets closer. The reason for the assessment happening at school before the beginning of the year is to start our staggered schedule as soon as school begins.

We will be having TK/Kindergarten orientation on **Tuesday, August 16, from 10:00-11:00 AM**.

We want every student and his or her family to be very comfortable with SRTMS. We ask that each student and at least one parent attend our TK/Kindergarten orientation. Students will meet the teachers and each other, see the classrooms, participate in some fun academic activities, and get a chance to play. There will also be a parent-only meeting where parents will learn more about the TK /Kindergarten program at SRTMS. Please note the classrooms will not fully be set up at the time of the orientation, but they will be ready for the first day of school.

We are sending you a home assessment that you can complete with your child. Please make sure that your child completes the assessment as independently as possible. We ask that you bring the home assessment with you when you come for orientation. The home assessment is just for us to get a better idea of what your child knows coming into SRTMS.

Your child's teacher assignment will be available in Parent Connect on August 19 at 4:00 PM. We will be spending the first few days of school getting to know your child so he/she will feel comfortable in the classroom.

Again more detailed information will be sent to you in August. However, please make every effort to have August 15 and 16 available so your child can attend orientation and take the assessment. It is the best way to make sure you soar high next year. We look forward to seeing you.




