Dear TK and Kindergarten Families,

We are very much looking forward to our TK and kindergarten friends join us next week.

Please remember that we are in AM and PM cohorts. I will refer you to my Back to Campus letter for the master schedule and many details. There are some important details I want to make sure I address with you that affect only TK/kindergarten.

First, as hard as it is, parents are not allowed past the gate of the campus. Our campus supervisors and I will be there to ensure that your child gets to class without a problem. For our AM cohort, Mrs. Argo's class will enter through the bus gate, and Mrs. Benitez will enter through our breezeway gate. All PM cohort students will enter through our kindergarten play yard gate at 11:10 AM, Also, all students, regardless of grade level, must wear a mask.

Secondly, TK/Kindergarten will be eating at tables and in individual chairs on the grass area where the school bell is located. We will play in the kindergarten play yard.

Third, there a few families that may not be comfortable bringing their students to campus. So, to help accommodate this need, students will be able complete school work asynchronously at home. We will offer a class meeting at a point during the cohort time. Your teacher will select the cohort and the time where your child can view the class meeting. Over a period of a number of weeks, we will incorporate the daily math and ELA lesson. However, this program won't be fully implemented until after Winter Break. Also, there should be no expectation that your teacher can interact or call on your child if they are viewing at home. Your teacher is just providing access to the lessons, and following the direction provided by our Educational Services department and me. I'm sure you can understand managing kindergarten age students who are on campus that all your teacher's efforts. The work for those students staying at home will still be completed independently.

Lastly, our paid childcare program will be open 7-8 AM and 10:30 AM - 6 PM daily. We also have our campus supervision at no cost from 8 AM -1:40 PM daily (if space is available).

We understand there are many new procedures and protocols. Still, we can't wait to see your child.
