

Student Absence and Return to School Policy

If your student was absent or sent home for symptoms commonly found with Covid-19 or other viral infections. This is a friendly reminder that prior to your student returning to school you must provide one of the following:

1. Documentation from a healthcare provider for an underlying chronic health condition that matches your student's symptoms **OR**
2. Negative SARS_CoV-2 test (**home test kits are accepted***) **OR**
3. Healthcare provider confirmed alternate diagnosis

*Home Test Kits: You may download your response digitally via the QR code on the side of the box, **or** you may submit a photo of the test cassette. You will need to include the following information in the photo of your student's test cassette:*

- *Student's first and last name.*
- *The date and time the test was read (per the kit instructions.)*

You may also present the information in person to our office staff. Remember to bring your student to our office for their Health Check-in prior to them entering the gates on campus.

Additionally, please continue to keep your child home if they:

- Have a fever greater than 100° (may return to school if fever is normal for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medicine.)
- Have vomited in the last 24 hours.
- Have cold symptoms, including but not limited to increased colorful nasal discharge and persistent cough.
- Have diarrhea.
