Camarillo, CA – Pleasant Valley School District superintendent named finalist in Midland, Texas. The Midland ISD Board of Trustees has named Dr. Angelica Ramsey as their lone finalist to be the district's next superintendent. The announcement came Thursday night after the board completed its second round of interviews and voted unanimously to name Ramsey.

"We are not surprised that a successful leader such as Dr. Ramsey was highly sought after by a large district like Midland ISD. We are confident that the systems and capacity built in her tenure will allow PVSD to flourish. We wish her all the best and know Midland is lucky to have her," said Beckie Cramer, Board President.

Dr. Ramsey has served as the Superintendent of Schools for Pleasant Valley School District since July 2016. Under her leadership, PVSD created and published a three-year strategic plan entitled Vision 2020: Excellence for All. The plan outlined newly formulated goals, articulated commitments aligned to LCAP priorities, and identified specific strategies to meet goals. The District also published a Master Facilities Plan which led to a successful \$119 MIL school bond measure to ensure 21st century learning environments, upgrades to aging infrastructure, and implementation of safety measures.

"It has been an honor of a lifetime serving as PVSD's superintendent of schools. I plan to work closely with the Board during the transition," said Dr. Angelica Ramsey.

Due to Texas law, the MISD board will wait a period of 21 days before voting on the hire. The PVSD Board anticipates beginning a search for a new superintendent next month with the intent of having that person in place by July 1, 2021.

Pleasant Valley School District proudly operates six elementary schools, two middle schools, two transitional kindergarten through eighth grade schools, and one kindergarten through eighth grade school serving an estimated enrollment for fiscal 2019 of 6,383 students. Across its campuses, PVSD prepares 21<sup>st</sup> century learners who are responsible members of our global society.
