

SAFETY AND SECURITY. Provider shall be responsible for ascertaining from the District all of the rules and regulations pertaining to safety, security, and driving on school grounds, particularly when children are present.

Providers that contract with a school district are required to comply with Education Code section 45125.1 regarding fingerprinting requirements unless the District determines that the Provider will have limited contact with students.

- Provider will have **NO** contact with or access to students. Fingerprinting not required.
- Provider will have contact with and access to students with constant supervision by PVSD employee. Fingerprinting not req'd.
- Provider will have unsupervised contact with and access to students **MUST** have clear fingerprints on file with the PVSD HR Department prior to event.

INSURANCE. Provider, at its own cost and expense, shall procure and maintain during the term of this Agreement, policies of insurance for the following types of coverage:

1. **Workers' Compensation Insurance.** Provider shall procure and maintain, during the term of this Agreement, Workers' Compensation Insurance, as required by California law, on all of its employees engaged in work related to the performance of this Agreement.
2. **Commercial General Liability Insurance.** Provider shall procure and maintain, during the term of this Agreement, not less than the following General Liability Insurance coverage in the amounts of \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 aggregate. Commercial General Liability insurance shall include products/completed operations, broad form property damage, and personal and advertising injury coverage.
3. **Automobile Liability.** Provider shall procure and maintain, during the full term of this Agreement the following Automobile Liability Insurance with the following coverage limits:
 - Personal vehicles: \$500,000.00 combined single limit or \$100,000.00 per person / \$300,000.00 per accident
 - Commercial vehicles: \$1,000,000.00 combined single limit
4. **Abuse and Molestation.** Provider shall procure and maintain, during the term of this Agreement, Abuse and Molestation coverage in the amounts of \$1,000,000 per occurrence and \$2,000,000 aggregate.

Certificates of Insurance. Provider and any and all vendors and subcontractors working for Provider shall provide certificates of insurance to the District as required, at least **20** days prior to the proposed activity, and at any other time upon the request of the District. **Provider's Commercial General Liability insurance, Auto and Abuse and Molestation coverage shall name Pleasant Valley School District, 600 Temple Ave., Camarillo, CA, 93010, as additional insured, with endorsement page(s).** Insurance written on a "claims made" basis is to be renewed by the Provider and all Provider subcontractors for a period of five (5) years following termination of this Agreement. Such insurance must have the same coverage and limits as the policy that was in effect during the term of this agreement, and will cover the Provider for all claims made.

Failure to Procure Insurance. Failure on the part of Provider, or any of its subcontractors, to procure or maintain required insurance shall constitute a material breach of contract under which the District may immediately terminate this Agreement.
